## St. Bernadette UMDF Collection Total is Amazing!

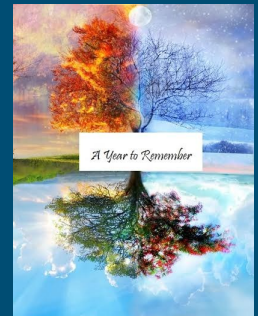
Here are our UMDF winning totals for the GINA JUG COLLECTIONS!

Thanks so much to the entire St. Bernadette School community for assisting UMDF with their collection in Gina's memory!

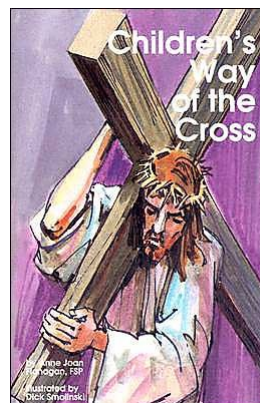

## St. Bernadette Holds a Mother/Son Dance--February 20, 2016!

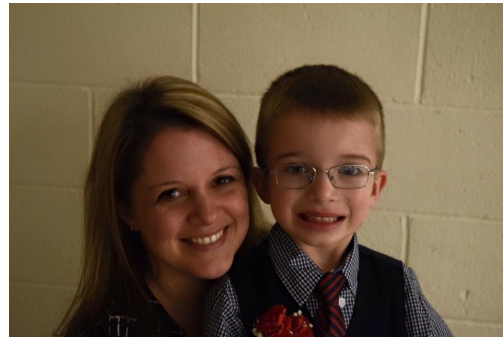

St. Bernadette School recently sent one Robotics team to the Pittsburgh Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers INDEEE 500 cm. Robot Race! It was held at the Carnegie Science Center on Saturday, February 20th! The students have to build their robot, program their robot to follow a white line serpentine course and then begin racing in heats for a bracketed position! The final races are single elimination after the heats are finished!
