WHERE LEARNING IS A HOOT!!

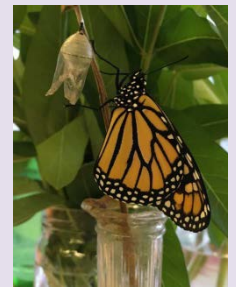
My name is Ms. Susan Sowa and I am the Math, Science/Health, and Social Studies teacher for second grade and I teach Religion to my homeroom.
